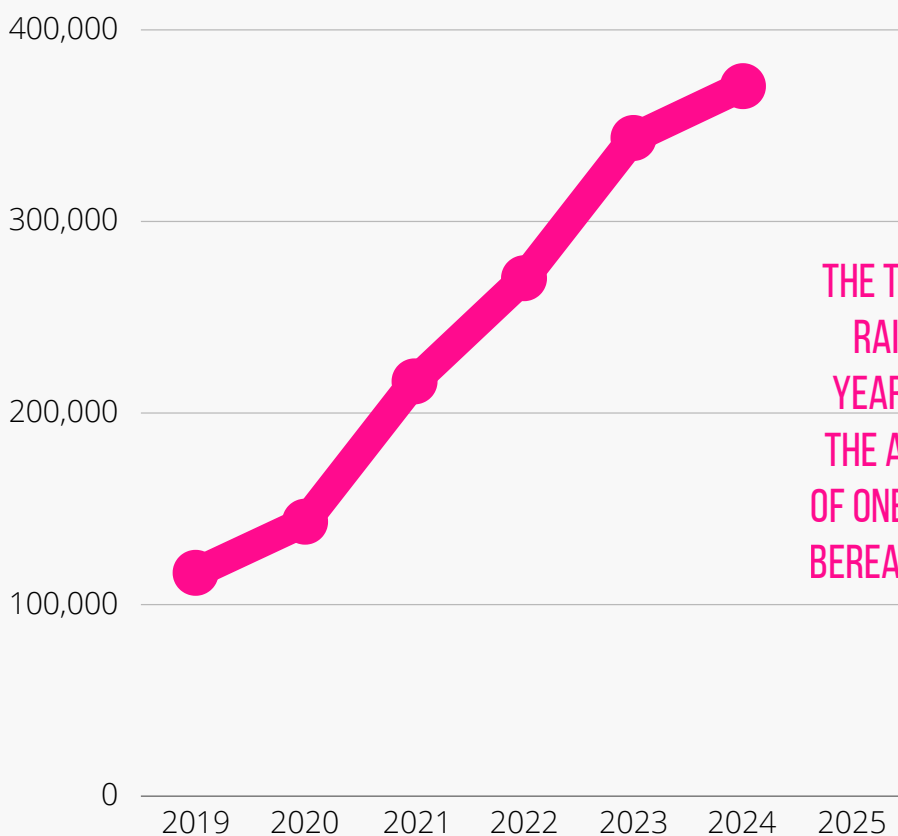


No Foot Too Small 12th Annual Gala
